**Name of the band:** **VEGET** (Do not confuse us with vegetable, we are not vegetarians. In Czech „veget“ means very leisure and pleasant time with twiddling fingers.)

**The band has existed since:** March 2000

**Musical style:** most of all bluegrass, folk and folk-grass (our original label for songs that include both bluegrass and folk influences). It is clear, that our music is suitable primarily for listeners who are not strictly aimed at one particular musical style. We usually try to adapt the repertoire according to the type of the event we are attending.
